

CODE OF CONDUCT AND RULES FOR

USE OF OUTDOOR NET FACILITIES

Players and <u>authorized</u> visitors are required to:

- 1. Be suitably dressed for their activity.
- 2. Remove any litter from in and around the facility.
- 3. Hand in any lost property as soon as possible to a club official or bar staff.
- 4. Comply with the No Smoking policy on the premises, or around the facilities
- 5. Refrain from bringing any glass bottles, cans etc into the facility including the external areas. Only drinks with sports bottle tops to be used whilst using the nets.
- 6. Refrain from using foul and abusive language, as well as displaying acts of violent/threatening behaviour.
- 7. Wear appropriate footwear (no spikes) and equipment. ALL UNDER 18'S MUST WEAR HELMETS WHEN A HARD BALL IS BEING USED.
- 8. Refrain from climbing the perimeter fencing.
- 9. Ensure that the area and equipment used is left in good condition and tidy after use.
- 10. Report any concerns or incident that may affect the safety of anyone using the facility.
- 11. Observe the Code of Conduct and carry out all other instructions published by notice or otherwise by THE CLUB, relating to the use of the facility and comply with all reasonable requests by the club.
- 12. Pay to THE CLUB on demand the amount of any damage caused to any equipment, fixtures or fittings (other than that caused by fair wear and tear), by themselves or any person under their care or control. The amount for such damage shall be determined by the Club.
- 13. Indemnify THE CLUB against all claims, demands, actions and proceedings in respect of death or injury to any persons, or damage to, or loss of property belonging to any person arising out of the use of this facility otherwise than as a result of defective condition of the facility or equipment, or negligence of THE CLUB.
- 14. No unauthorized person should be taken into the nets by another member without prior permission.

THE NETS ARE TO BE USED FOR CRICKET RELATED ACTIVITIES ONLY AND HAVE BEEN PROVIDED FOR ALL CLUB MEMBERS TO HELP THEM REACH THEIR FULL POTENTIAL
